## **FOX PLANTER**



## **MATERIALS**

134 **Medium Round Brush** Fox Planter

**DOTG01** Dotting Gyre **Liner Brush** Pencil **Fan Brush** 

## GLAZES

SC002 Melon-Choly SC024 Dandelion SC075 Orange-A-Peel SC015 Tuxedo

SC016 Cotton Tail

## INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** Sketch the shapes onto the face and body of the fox -- eyes, stomach, tail and legs.
- 2. Use a medium round brush to fill in the eye-mask, chest, and tip of the tail with 2-3 coats of Cotton Tail.
- 3. Use a medium round or fan brush to fill in the rest of the body with 2-3 coats of Melon-
- **4.** When dry, use a liner brush to put a thick outline of 3 coats of Orange-A-Peel around the eye-mask, chest, and tail.
- **5.** Use a liner brush to add Orange-A-Peel dashes around the body of the planter.
- **6.** Use a liner brush to fill in the center of the ears with 3 coats of Orange-A-Peel.
- **7.** Use a liner brush to paint eye circles on the eye-mask with 2-3 coats of Dandelion. Add a fluff (a wavy line) of Dandelion on the chest.
- **8.** Use a pencil to stech toes on the feet of the planter. Use the liner brush to paint the legs with 2-3 coats of Tuxedo, avoiding the toes.
- **9.** Use a liner brush to paint the toes with 3 coats of Cotton Tail, once the Tuxedo is dry.
- **10.** Use a liner brush to paint Tuxedo pupils, tips of the ears, mouth, and a stripe on the tail.
- **11.** Dip a tip of the Dotting Gyre into Cotton Tail and add a glint in each eye.
- **12.** Let dry. Clear glaze. Fire to cone 06.
