

FLOWER DOODLE BOWL

This Flower Doodle Bowl is giving off retro, fun and happy vibes! The best part? This floral design can be altered to fit on other bowls, plates, mugs, and more!

MATERIALS

3106	Flared Shallow Bowl	Assorted Brushes
9599	Hydra Art Sponge	Pencil
DOTG01	Dotting Gyre	Toothbrush

GLAZES

SC002	Melon-Choly	SC089	Cutie Pie Coral
SC009	Jaded	SC097	Cant-elope
SC070	Pink-A-Dot	SC102	Just Peachy
SC088	Tu Tu Tango		



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the bowl with a clean Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Use a pencil to gently sketch 3 concentric circles in the center of the bowl.
3. Sketch arch-shaped petals around the outer circle.
4. Use a liner brush to outline the innermost circle with 2 coats Pink-A-Dot.
5. Outline the middle circle with 2 coats of Just Peachy.
6. Outline the outer circle with 2 coats of Melon-Choly.
7. Outline the flower petals with 2-3 coats of Pink-A-Dot.
8. Use a round brush to paint one coat of Pink-A-Dot in the center circle.
9. Brush one coat of Pink-A-Dot in each petal shape.
10. Brush one coat of Just Peachy around the middle circle.
11. Brush one coat of Melon-Choly around the outer circle.
12. Re-outline the concentric circles with 1 additional coat of color.
13. Add dots to the center circle and flower petals using a Dotting Gyre and Cutie Pie Coral.
14. Add horizontal dashes to the middle circle using a liner brush and Cant-elope.
15. Add vertical stripes to the outer circle using a liner brush and Tu Tu Tango.
16. Use a large round brush to fill in the background with 3 coats of Jaded. Leave an unpainted border around the flower doodle.
17. Allow the project to dry completely, then clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
