

GOOD VIBES BOWL

MATERIALS

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Dust off the bowl with a dry hydra art sponge.
2. Place the template on the Saral transfer paper and cut the template out to create a round template and round piece of transfer paper.
3. Place the Saral transfer paper shiny side down inside the center of the bowl and place the template on top.
4. Use a dull pencil to firmly trace the template design, transferring it to the bowl, then remove them to reveal the disco ball outline.

TIP: Hold the template steady on one side and peek below to ensure you traced all of the lines. If you missed anything, lay it back down and trace what you missed. If you removed the template and realize lines are missing, use a #2 pencil to lightly sketch in the missing lines.

5. Mix silkscreen medium with Tuxedo glaze, and apply the Good Vibes Silkscreen to the center of the bowl using the process below:
 - a. Squirt a quarter-sized amount of Tuxedo on a flat palette.
 - b. Sprinkle a pinch of silkscreen medium over the glaze and use a toothpick or end of a paint brush to mix to a creamy, peanut butter-like consistency.
 - c. Place the screen in the center of the bowl over the disco ball design and hold it securely in place.
 - d. Scoop up some of the mixture from step b with your finger and press and rub it through the silkscreen design starting at the center and moving outwards in a circular motion.
 - e. Hold the screen in place on one side and gently lift the other side to see if the design looks good. If you missed a spot, lay it back down and repeat step d.
 - f. Remove the silkscreen to reveal the design.
 - g. Rinse off your silkscreen and lay it out to dry. **Tip: Do not let glaze dry on your silkscreens.**
6. Using a script liner and fan brush, paint the area around the disco ball with 2-3 coats of Vanilla Dip.
7. Mix a dime size amount of Orange-a-peel and Crackerjack Brown together and water down to a skim milk consistency. Water down a dime size amount of Blue Isle and Tiger Tail as well. Use these colors to "tint" in the Good Vibes design using the script liner and detail liner brushes.



8. Use square shader and detail brushes to fill in the disco ball w/ 1-2 coats of (Tiger Tail, Blue Isle, Bluebeard, Basketball, Melon-Choly, Brown Cow).
9. Paint the sparkly diamond designs on the disco ball w/ 1-2 coats of vanilla dip.
10. Use a #2 pencil to lightly sketch sparkly diamond and star shapes around the inner rim of the bowl. Paint the stars and diamonds with 2-3 coats of the colors of your choice.
11. Add a drop or two of water to a dime-sized puddle of Tuxedo to thin it a bit, then use the detail liner to outline the disco ball squares, diamonds, and stars.
12. Paint the outside of the bowl (including the rim) w/ 2-3 coats of Orange-A-Peel mixed with Crackerjack Brown. Use Tuxedo to add dash marks around the rim and inside the bowl.

TIP: Use a hydra art sponge to apply color to the rim in a clean line by dipping the sponge into color and then rubbing the color along the rim.

13. Dip a toothbrush into Tuxedo and add splatter to the inside of the bowl.
14. Clear glaze and fire to Cone 06. Enjoy!
