## **HEIRLOOM STEIN**

## MATERIALS

2842	The Des Stein
9599	Hydra Art Sponge
C500-Fan4	Cobalt Fan Brush #4
C500-R4	Cobalt Round Brush #4
RB110	10/0 Detail Liner

## GLAZES

HSC552	Jadeite
HSC577	Spruce
HSC565	Cinnamon
HSC550	Rustic Brown
HSC553	Reactive White
HSC551	Egyptian Blue



## INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** Dust off the stein with a dry hydra art sponge.
- 2. Paint 1 coat of Rustic Brown on the handle, rim, beaded section around the top of the stein, and the base of the stein with a round brush.
- **3.** Use a Fan Brush to apply 2 coats of Jadeite to the outside of the stein, covering the Rustic Brown. Be sure to paint the bottom of the stein with 2-3 coats of Jadeite.
- **4.** Paint 2 Coats of Cinnamon inside of the stein.
- **5.** Paint 1 thin coat of Spruce to the inside and outside of the stein.
- **6.** Use a Detail Liner to apply Egyptian Blue to simulate drips around the rim and beaded band at the top half of the stein.

- 7. Load a dry Fan Brush with Reactive White. Blot the brush on a paper towel to remove excess glaze, then dry brush a layer of Reactive White over the outside of the stein.
- 8. No Clear Glaze is required, however in order to be food-safe the entire surface of the stein must be glazed, including the inside and base. Prior to firing, verify that there is no exposed bisque. Fire to Cone 06. Enjoy!

**NOTE:** Results will vary depending on application, as Terra Bella glazes are reactive. Each project made will be unique. Enjoy the exciting reveal when you unload them from the kiln!
