

# LIGHTED COSMIC WIZARD

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the bisque with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Create a marbleizing effect on the wizard's hat! First, gently squirt a thin stream of Blue Isle in a zigzag pattern onto a paper towel. This stream of glaze needs to be roughly as wide as the hat.
3. Rotating the paper towel roughly 90 degrees between each color, gently add thin streams of Pinkie Swear, Purplicious, Moody Blue, and Tuxedo.
4. Press the paper towel onto the side of the hat and twist it slightly to marbleize the colors. Be sure not to smooch or twist the paper towel, or else the colors may become muddled.
5. Gently peel off the paper towel. Fill in any missed areas by pressing the paper towel into those spots.
6. If the colors start to muddle together, repeat steps #2-5 using a new paper towel. Repeat until all areas of the hat have been covered by color.
7. Use a Cleaning Tool to unblock the cutouts of any excess paint.
8. Using a Fan Brush, paint 1-2 coats of Lavendear and Blue Isle on the beard.
9. Take a damp Hydra Art Sponge and wipe away the excess glaze. This will leave color in the nooks and crannies of the beard.
10. Repeat this antiquing technique on the eyebrows.
11. Paint 2-3 coats of Makin' Me Blush on the face.
12. Paint 2-3 coats of Lavendear on the rim of the hat and the ball of the hat.
13. Mix a dot of Pinkie Swear with a dot of Makin' Me Blush to create a muted pink tone. Use this for the cheeks and lips of the wizard.
14. Mix Tuxedo and Lavendear to create a gray tone. Use this color to add eyelashes to the eyes.
15. Lightly sketch each iris with a pencil.
16. Paint each iris with 1 coat of Lavendear.
17. Add accents of Blue Isle, Purplicious, and Moody Blue to each iris.
18. Use a Dotting Gyre on spoke 8 to add Tuxedo pupils.
19. Create a "fluffy" outline on the rim and ball of the hat with Purplicious.
20. Mix Tuxedo, Moody Blue, and Makin' me blush to create a darker skin tone. Paint the nostrils.
21. Add some Lavendear and Blue Isle accents on the eyebrows.
22. Once the hat is dry, use White French Dimensions to add additional starry "dots".
23. Dip a toothbrush into Cotton Tail, then rub the bristles with your thumb next to the hat to create white splatter over the entire galaxy-inspired hat.
24. Water down some Tuxedo to a wash consistency and tint inside the inner edges of the star cutouts on the hat.
25. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
26. **Optional:** After the wizard has been clear glazed and fired, apply 1 swirly coat of Mother of Pearl all over the beard, eyebrows, and galaxy design on the hat. Fire to Cone 020. This will make your wizard shiny and iridescent. Enjoy!
