

Cozy Morning Mug



supplies

Potter's Mug Item #2704
Foundations Matte
Marshmallow White #FN-301
Elements Autumn #EL-133
Pottery Cascades #White PC-602
Stroke and Coat Tuxedo #SC-15



instructions

- 1. Draw an organic horizontal line across the body of the mug with a pencil.
- Use a fan brush to paint a thick coat of FOUNDATIONS MATTE MARSHMALLOW
 WHITE on the bottom of the mug, under the line you drew. Don't skip the handle or the inside!
- 3. Allow to dry and paint another thick coat of FOUNDATIONS MATTE MARSHMALLOW WHITE. Repeat and apply a third, even coat.
- 4. When dry, dip a liner brush into TUXEDO and add black dashes on top of the matte white. Don't skip the handle and inside of the mug! Experiment with other markshorizontal or vertical stripes, circles, dots, stars, etc.
- 5. When the black marks are dry, use a fan brush to paint a thick coat of ELEMENTS AUTUMN on the unpainted areas- above the matte, inside, and the handle. Let dry.
- Paint another thick coat of AUTUMN. Let dry. Apply another coat. The last coat doesn't need to be perfectly even-some textured brushstrokes will do cool things when fired.
- 7. When dry, apply a thick coat of WHITE CASCADES on top of the AUTUMN. Let drip. Where the glaze is thick, it will be fire very white, so notice how the glaze is dripping on your mug and adjust to your liking. Keep the drips above the matte glaze so the Cascades don't run off the mug and onto the kiln shelf when fired.
- 8. Allow to dry. Do not dip. Fire to cone 06.
