Shine Mason Jar Pitcher



Shine bright with the help of Colorobbia's Bellissimo and Fairy Dust glazes!

Supplies

Mason Jar Pitcher #2630 Liner Brush Small Round Brush Medium Round Brush Pencil

Sweet Dreams BLS927 Snow Queen BLS905
Midnight Bleu BLS950 Moonglow HSS115
Apricot Stone BLS902 Dusty Clear Fairy Dust HSS005



Instructions

- 1. Use a pencil to lightly sketch 1.5-2.5 inch circles around the pitcher, leaving a space for lettering somewhere on the front of the pitcher.
- Pour out piles of Sunny Tuscany, Banana Cream, Apricot Stone, and Snow Queen onto your paint palette.
- 3. Use a medium round brush to fill in the circles with Sunny Tuscany. While the paint is still wet, swipe in circular brushstrokes of Apricot Stone on the outside of the circle.
- 4. Fill in the center of the circles with Banana Cream.
- 5. Heavily load a medium round brush into Sweet Dreams and paint in short, expressive strokes around the penciled in circles. While the paint is wet, brush in strokes of Midnight Bleu. Use a medium brush loaded with Moonglow to blend the Midnight Bleu into the Sweet Dreams.
- 6. Add dashes of Dusty Clear inside the circles.
- 7. Paint the rim of the pitcher with Arazmatazz.
- 8. Paint the handle of the pitcher with Midnight Bleu.
- 9. When the circles are dry, lightly sketch a firefly inside the circle. The body is a teardrop, the head is a small circle, and the wings are two tear drops on either side of the body.
- 10. Sketch "Shine" onto the pitcher. Use a liner brush and Snow Queen to fill in the letters.
- 11. Dip a pencil eraser in Black Swan and add a dot to the head of each firefly.
- 12. Use a liner brush to add black details- firefly wings, body, and black dashes randomly along the pitcher.
- 13. Splatter the pitcher.
- 14. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
