

Tidal Wave Platter

TECHNIQUE SHEET



supplies

- 966 Interlink Platter
- BLS905 Snow Queen
- BLS927 Sweet Dreams
- BLS962 Teal
- BLS928 Blue Lagoon
- HSC551 Egyptian Blue
- HSC554 Ocean Mist
- HSC553 Reactive White
- C500-R10 Cobalt Round Brush #10
- C500-S4 Cobalt Script Brush #4
- C500-F4 Cobalt Fan Brush #4
- Pencil



instructions

1. Lightly sketch some wavy lines and swirls diagonally across your platter with a pencil.
2. Start by painting in some of your wavy stripes with 2-3 coats of Snow Queen, Sweet Dreams, Teal, and Blue Lagoon. Leave a few of the sections blank for now. You can use your #10 Round Brush for this.
3. Next, fill in the blank areas with 2-3 coats of Egyptian Blue and Ocean Mist. Let your platter dry for a couple of minutes.
4. Then using your Script Liner Brush, outline your waves with 2 coats Egyptian Blue and Ocean Mist.
5. Next, paint some skinny stripes over top of the larger stripes with either Egyptian Blue or Ocean Mist. Let everything dry.
6. Using your Fan Brush, flip your platter over and paint 2-3 coats of Ocean Mist on the back. Let dry.
7. Finally, paint 2 coats of Reactive White on the front and back of your platter. Use your Fan Brush for this.
8. No Clear Glaze is required! Fire to Cone 06 and enjoy the tranquil flow of this Tidal Wave platter!
