



MATERIALS

3205	Burnie Bones Chiminea	#2 Pencil
8010	½" Art Tape (optional)	Assorted Brushes
9599	Hydra Art Sponge	Sandworm Template
SARALRED	Saral Transfer Paper	Scissors

GLAZES

SC005	Tiger Tail	SC027	Sour Apple

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the bisque with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Transfer the sandworm template onto the forehead of the piece using Saral red transfer paper, the printed sandworm template, and a pencil. Lay the transfer paper - shiny side down - on the bisque and position the template over the transfer paper. Be sure to hold the template in place with either your hand or ½" Art Tape. Firmly trace the template design using a pencil. Peel off the transfer paper and template to reveal the sandworm head design. Touch up any areas with a pencil as needed.
3. Use the pencil to sketch the rest of the sandworm's body wrapping around the back of the chiminea, then draw stripes going down the sandworm's body.
4. Paint the sandworm using Tuxedo, Hot Tamale, Blue Isle, and Tiger Tail. Refer to the sample for color positions. No need to paint the sandworm with Cotton Tail, simply leave any areas that are white "blank".
5. Use a detail liner brush to outline the sandworm design with Tuxedo.
6. Use the pencil to sketch the hairline around Burnie Bones' face, then sketch funky eyebrows above the skeleton's eyes.
7. Paint the skeleton teeth with 1 coat of Tuxedo.
8. "Antique" the teeth by wiping off excess Tuxedo glaze using a damp Hydra Art Sponge.
9. Using the dirty sponge, add some smudges all over the face.
10. Outline the hairline with Sour Apple.
11. Outline the sandworm with Sour Apple, then paint 2-3 coats of Sour Apple around the chiminea to fill in the hair. Be sure to paint approximately 2 inches down the inner rim of the chiminea as well.
12. Use a liner brush, Irish Luck, and Green Thumb to add swirling hair lines and accents on the hair around the chiminea. Add darker green outlines and accents over the hairline.
13. Paint 2-3 coats of Grapel around the eye sockets and inner edges of the eyes.
14. Paint 1 coat of Tuxedo inside the inner edge of the nose.
15. Outline the eyes with Tuxedo and add black accent lines around the eyes over the Grapel circles.
16. Fill in the funky eyebrows with 2 coats of Tuxedo.
17. Water down Poo Bear to a skim milk consistency. Add 1 coat of this yellow wash over the teeth.
18. Touch up any black outlines on the sandworm as needed with a detail liner.
19. Add Cotton Tail accents over the Tuxedo stripes on the sandworm. Touch up any teeth with Cotton Tail as needed.
20. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06. Enjoy!
