

POPPIN' PINEAPPLE LAMP



MATERIALS

CC-1984 Lighted Pineapple Lamp C500-Fan4 Cobalt Fan Brush #4
9599 Hydra Art Sponge RB110 Detail Liner 10/0

GLAZES

SC0488 Camel Back SC024 Dandelion
SC026 Green Thumb SC025 Crackerjack Brown

INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** Paint 1 coat of Camel Back all over the pineapple using fan brush. Let the paint dry for a few minutes, then take a damp Hydra Art Sponge and rub off the excess glaze so that the brown is only in the creases of the pineapple.
- **2.** Repeat this step using Green Thumb.
- **3.** Using fan brush, water down some Dandelion & paint 2 thin coats all over the pineapple.
- **4.** Water down Green Thumb & paint 2 thin coats on the leaves. You can use a Detail Liner and a Fan brush for this part. Let the glaze dry.
- **5.** Water down Crackerjack Brown & lightly brush around the entire pineapple including the leaves & let dry.
- **6.** Go over the leaves lightly with watered down Green Thumb one more time
- **7.** Make sure all the holes are clean and not clogged up with glaze before firing.
- **8.** Clear Glaze and fire to Cone 06! Let this Poppin' Pineapple Lamp brighten up your day!
