

## **UNDER THE SEA TREE**



## **MATERIALS**

3034Large Lighted Christmas TreeDish SoapC500-EF8Cobalt Essential Fan - 8StrawC500-F8Cobalt Filbert - 8Small Cup

**AC-5232** Non-fired Snow 2 ounce

**TTWIST38** Large Sea Creature Lights Assortment

## **GLAZES**

EL125Sahara SandsSC076Cara-bein BlueSC028Blue IsleSC029Blue Grass

**SCO11** Blue Yonder

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. With your fan brush water down Blue Isle and Blue Yonder glaze. Then using your fan brush create watercolor like splotches all over the entire tree (excluding the base). Overlap some of the color splotches. Let your tree dry.
- 2. While your tree is drying, take the base and paint 2-3 coatsof Sahara Sands Elements Glaze using your fan brush. Don't worry once it is fired it will be the correct color!
- **3.** Set aside the base to dry, then mix up your bubble glaze solution.
- **4.** Take a small cup and add 2 parts Cara-Bein Blue Glaze, 1 part water, and 2-3 drops of dish soap. Mix together thoroughly with your straw.
- 5. Then holding the cup at a slight angle, blow into your straw creating bubbles that overflow out of the cup onto your tree. Move around the tree holding the cup and blowing bubbles. It's okay if you have a few drips here and there, after all this is an ocean tree! Make sure your tree has bubbles all over!
- **6.** Next water down some Blue Grass Glaze with your fan brush. Then load your fan brush with the watered down glaze and hold it over the tree and lightly tap the brush with your finger to let some of the Blue Grass splatter all over the tree.



Move around the tree and add as much splatter as you want! Let your tree dry completely. No clear glaze is required! Fire to Cone 06!

- 7. After firing, take your filbert brush and add splotches of Non Fired Snow to the end of the branches on the tree to create the white sea foam from crashing waves! Let this dry completely.
- **8.** Don't forget to add in your ocean themed light bulbs and plug your tree in. You will love the gorgeous glow of this ocean tree!
