

WINTER WONDERLAND CANISTER

MATERIALS

2894	Hexagon Canister	Toothbrush
9599	Hydra Art Sponge	Straight Pin
STK112	Snowflake Sticker Stencil	1 Sheet of Copy Paper
R2090	Wool Sponge	
C500-Fan4	Cobalt Fan Brush #4	
C500- S4	Cobalt Script Liner	

GLAZES

SC086	Old Lace	SC091	Seabreeze
SC012	Moody Blue	SC028	Blue Isle
SC030	Blue Dawn	SC053	Purple Haze



INSTRUCTIONS

- Dust off the canister with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
- Place a large snowflake sticker in the center of the knob on the lid. Use a straight pin to gently lift up the edges of the delicate sticker off the sheet.
- Apply the rest of the snowflake stickers around the bottom half of the canister.
- Rip a piece of copy paper to create thin tapered icicle shapes. (Rip downwards at an angle)
- Paint one solid coat of Old Lace with a Fan Brush on one of the flat panels on the canister (it's okay to paint over the stickers). Stick down a few of the paper icicle shapes flush with the top of the canister. Rip and tear any of the paper pieces if they need to be adjusted. Don't cover up the snowflake stickers.
- Paint a layer of Old Lace over top of the paper icicles to secure them down.
- Repeat Steps 5 and 6 til all the panels of the canister have icicles applied.
- Paint 1 solid coat of Old Lace over the entire outside of the canister lid.
- Pour Moody Blue, Purple Haze, Blue Isle, Blue Dawn, and Seabreeze on the palette.
- Sponge a solid coat of Moody blue over the top 3rd of the canister over the icicles with wool sponge. Dab excess off the sponge.
- With Purple haze repeat step 9 underneath the Moody blue blending the colors together where they meet.
- Repeat steps 9 and 10 going down the canister using Blue Isle, Blue Dawn, and Seabreeze to create an ombre effect.
- On the lid, sponge Moody blue on the outer edge and follow the same steps to ombre the other colors going towards the knob on the lid.
- Sponge Seabreeze on top of the snowflake sticker on the knob, then add a light sponged layer of moody blue over top.
- While the sponged glaze is still wet, take a straight pin and carefully lift up the snowflake stickers and peel them off to reveal a crisp white snowflake design. Be sure to remove all of the stickers (there should be 4 large snowflakes and 8 small snowflakes)
- While the sponged colors are still damp, take the tapered end of the paint brush and scrape swirly windy lines around the icicles and snowflakes into the glaze. Do this all around the canister and the lid.
- Take a Script Liner Brush and add some Old Lace glaze to fill in in between the icicles around the top rim of the canister. Paint small icicles around the knob of the lid using Old Lace. Add strokes of Seabreeze inside the icicles for texture.
- Take a toothbrush and dip the bristles into Old Lace and rub the bristles with your finger near the canister to create white splatter.
- Clear Glaze and Fire to Cone 06!
