

Cup of Joy

It's impossible to be anything but joyful when this cup is in hand. Customize it by adding a monogram or date to the ornament!



Supplies

Fancy a Cuppa'? (#2655)

Pencil

Liner Brush

Small Round Brush

Medium Round Brush

Color

Candy Apple Red SC-73

Tuxedo SC-15

Cotton Tail SC-16

Old Lace SC-86

Rawhide SC-46

Poo Bear SC-51



Instructions

1. Sketch or trace the design onto the mug.
2. Fill in the oval using Old Lace and a small round brush.
3. Use a liner brush to paint the laurels and the top and bottom details Cotton Tail.
4. Outline the Old Lace oval with Raw Hide using a liner brush.
5. Fill in the ornament hook with Poo Bear and the liner brush.
6. Fill in the rest of the ornament with Candy Apple Red, carefully painting around the white details and the oval.
7. Sketch the word "JOY" lightly inside the oval with pencil. Fill in the letters using a liner brush and Candy Apple Red.
8. Fill in the background and inside of the mug Tuxedo. Do not paint the ridged foot or the handle of the mug!
9. Paint the handle Old Lace.
10. Add Cotton Tail dots inside the letters using a liner brush.
11. Paint stars and dots around the letters using Poo Bear.
12. Add Tuxedo details to the ornament using a liner brush.
13. Use a liner brush to paint stripes of Poo Bear, Old Lace, and Candy Apple Red on the foot of the mug.
14. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
