

BEE MINE HONEY JAR

MATERIALS

1807	Sweet Honey Jar	DOTG01	Dotting Gyre
9599	Hydra Art Sponge	Assorted Brushes	

GLAZES

SC015	Tuxedo	SC046	Rawhide
SC016	Cotton Tail	SC101	Spruce It Up
SC024	Dandelion		

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the jar with a clean Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Paint the jar base with 3 coats of Rawhide. Let dry.
3. Paint the lid with 3 coats of Spruce It Up. Set aside to dry.
4. In scattered spots around the jar base, use a round brush and 2-3 coats of Dandelion to paint rounded bee bodies.
5. On each bee body, add two rounded wings using a round brush and 2-3 coats of Spruce It Up.
6. On each bee body, use a detail brush or liner brush to add thin Tuxedo stripes.
7. Use a liner brush to paint the embossed "Sweet Honey" letters with 2 coats of Tuxedo.
8. On the jar lid, dip a Dotting Gyre into Cotton Tail. Use a "dip and dot" technique to add Cotton Tail dots all around the lid surface.
9. Allow the project to dry completely, then clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
