Painting each section of this plate is so relaxing, you'll go into a zen state. Once fired, the combination of Mayco Elements and Stroke and Coat is truly magical!





Supplies

Toledo Salad Plate #806 Pencil Small Round Brush Medium Round Brush Liner Brush Fan Brush

Color

Vanilla Dip SC054 Tuxedo SC015 Sea Green Elements EL130P



Instructions

- 1. Lightly sketch the design onto the plate.
- 2. Fill in the design with 3 coats of Tuxedo.
- 3. Paint the background of the plate with 3 coats of Vanilla Dip, taking care to paint around the design. If you accidentally paint over parts of the design, that's okay– this look benefits from the glazes overlapping.
- 4. Sketch a rectangle in the upper left portion of the plate.
- 5. Fill in the rectangle, painting around the black design, with 3 coats of Sea Green.
- 6. Use a fan brush to paint the back of the plate with 3 coats of Sea Green.
- 7. Do not overglaze.
- 8. Fire to cone 06.

*Sea Green is dinnerware safe. Be sure to cover every aspect of the plate in at least 3 coats of glaze so that the plate is food safe. If you are worried you have left bare bisque showing, you can overglaze this piece, but not all Elements remain true to color when paired with clear dipping glaze.
