## **MATERIALS**

**GS9023** Girl Scout Campfire Treat Box

9599 Hydra Art Sponge

**Assorted Brushes** 

## **GLAZES**

**SCO25** Crackerjack Brown

SC015 Tuxedo

**SCOO2** Melon-Choly

SCO14 Java Bean

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Wipe down the bisque box with a clean Hydra Art Sponge.
- 2. Paint the graham crackers with 1 coat of Crackerjack Brown. Make sure to get the color inside all the nooks and crannies for best coverage!
- 3. Antique your Campfire Treat Box! First, dampen a Hydra Art Sponge. Then, use the damp sponge to wipe away the excess Crackerjack Brown from each graham cracker surface, leaving the color in the nooks and crannies on the crackers.
- **4.** Water down Crackerjack Brown to a skim milk consistency. Use 2 coats of the diluted color to paint the graham crackers.
- 5. Water down a dime-sized amount of Crackerjack Brown even more until it looks like a transparent watercolor color. Use the diluted color and a round brush to lightly brush around the base of the marshmallow and around the top of the marshmallow under the chocolate. This will give the marshmallow a toasted look!
- **6.** Add a second coat of watercolor Crackerjack Brown to the marshmallow towards the top area under the chocolate so it looks more "toasted," fading down into the center.
- **7.** Paint the chocolate with 3 coats of Java Bean.
- **8.** Paint the cheeks with 2 coats of Melon-Choly.
- **9.** Paint the eyes and mouth with 1 coat of Tuxedo.
- **10.** Allow the project to dry completely, then clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
