## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the canister with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Cut out the template along with a sheet of Saral Transfer Paper in a similar size. Place the transfer paper (shiny side down) on the side of the canister, then position the template over the transfer paper. Hold the template and transfer paper in place, then trace the design with a pencil. Lift off the template and transfer paper to reveal the traced design on your piece. Lightly trace over the design with pencil to make the lines a little darker.
3. Water down Vanilla Dip to a skim milk consistency. Paint 2 coats over the base of the canister (and over the traced design). Set aside to dry.
4. Time to ombré the lid! Paint the center of the mushroom cap with 2-3 coats of Poo Bear. Then, paint 2-3 coats of Tiger Tail around the center. Next, paint a ring of 2-3 coats of Orange-A-Peel. Lastly, paint the outer edge of the mushroom cap with 2-3 coats of Hot Tamale. Paint over the embossed dots.
5. Take a clean damp brush and blend the sections between the colors so that they fade into each other where they meet.
6. Before the lid dries completely, take the chiseled edge of your paint brush and scrape off the glaze left on the embossed dots.
7. Under the lid, paint 2-3 coats of Vanilla Dip then add some streaks of Poo Bear.
8. Use Cinnamon Stix to add lines (gills) all around the underside of the mushroom cap.
9. Paint the embossed dots on the lid with 2-3 coats of Cotton Tail.
10. Paint in the sketched mushroom designs with a variety of earth tone colors as desired. To create an olive green color, mix Irish Luck, Toad-Ily Green and Down to Earth together on your palette.
11. Paint the grass, laurels and greenery with Toad-Ily Green, Irish Luck, and Lettuce Alone.
12. Use Down to Earth to add outlines, shadows, and details as desired.
13. Add Cotton Tail highlights and dots on the mushrooms as desired.
14. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06. Enjoy!
