You'll be wild about this new mug from BI and even more wild for Duncan's Gold overglaze. Before long you'll be gilding everything!





Supplies

All About Them Angles Mug (2649)
Pencil
Liner Brush
Small Round Brush
Large Round Brush
Brush for Premium Gold

Pink A Boo SC-01 Tuxedo SC-15 Cheeky Pinky SC-17 Ruby Slippers SC-87 Duncan Premium Gold (OG805) Duncan Overglaze Essence (OA901)



Instructions

- 1. Paint the inside and outside of the mug with 2-3 coats of Pink-A-Boo using a large round brush.
- 2. When the background is dry, use a small round brush to add irregular oval shapes all over the mug with Cheeky Pinky. Vary the sizes and directions of the ovals for a more natural look.
- 3. When the spots are dry, use a liner brush to add partial outlines around each with Ruby Slippers. Some spots will have one line, while some will have two.
- 4. When the pattern is dry, sketch or transfer the phrase to the mug.
- 5. Use a liner brush and water to thin a small pile of Tuxedo to an ink-like consistency. Carefully fill the letters in with Tuxedo. To get the look of calligraphy, thicken the downstroke of each letter while keeping the upstrokes thin.
- 6. Splatter the mug with thinned Tuxedo.
- 7. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
- 8. Dip a new liner brush into Duncan Premium Gold. Apply a thin and even coat around the rim of the mug. Use the side of the brush to thin any thick spots.
- 9. Add a swipe of Premium Gold to random cheetah spots around the mug.
- 10. Wash the brush in and clean any mistakes with Overglaze Essence.
- 11. Fire to cone 018.
