INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe down the votive with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
- 2. Antique each coral section using different colors.
 - a. Coral #1: Paint the coral with 1 coat of Sour Apple. Dampen a Hydra Art Sponge, then wipe away excess glaze, allowing the color to remain in the crevices - this technique is known as antiquing. Then, paint the coral section with 2 coats of Slime Time.
 - **b.** Coral #2: Antique the coral using Pink-A-Boo. Then, paint the coral section with 2 coats of Melon-Choly.
 - **c.** Coral #3: Antique the coral using Lavendear. Then, paint the coral section with 2 coats of Orkid.
 - **d.** Coral #4: Antique the coral using Melon-Choly. Then, paint the coral section with 2 coats of Pink-A-Boo.
- 3. Paint each clam shell with 2-3 coats of Vanilla Dip.
- **4.** Using a detail or liner brush, add Brown Cow and Gray Hare accent lines to each clam shell.
- **5.** Paint the remaining background coral areas with the same colors listed above, ensuring no two neighboring sections are the same color.
- **6.** Paint the inner walls of the votives to match the outer coral section colors.
- **7.** In the inside center of the votive, use a #2 pencil to sketch a clownfish.





- **8.** Use the following colors to paint the clownfish: Gray Hare, Tuxedo, Orange Ya Happy, Cotton Tail, and Jack O' Lantern. See the sample image for reference.
- 9. Paint the background around the clown fish with 1-2 coats of Purple Haze. Paint sea anemone tentacles using 2-3 coats of Pinkie Swear. Accent the end of each tentacle with Lavendear.
- **10.** Clear glaze and fire to cone 06. Enjoy!
