## DAISY DAZE PLATE

## MATERIALS

2434	Funky Blooms Plate	<b>DOTG01</b> Dotting Gyre
8008	3/16" Art Tape	<b>Assorted Brushes</b>
9599	Hydra Art Sponge	Toothbrush

## **GLAZES**

<b>SC002</b>	Melon-Choly	SC016	Cotton Tail
SC009	Jaded	<b>SC024</b>	Dandelion
SC015	Tuxedo	SC028	Blue Isle

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the plate with a clean Hydra Art Sponge.

- 2. Adhere long strips of 3/16" Art Tape extending from the daisy to the plate rim in a "burst" fashion.
- 3. On your palette, mix Melon-Choly, Dandelion, Blue Isle, and Jaded with Cotton Tail in a 2-1 ratio. This will create a palette of retro-inspired pastel shades!
- 4. Paint the center of the daisy with 2-3 coats of the pastel-shaded Dandelion.
- 5. Alternate painting the "burst" stripes with each pastel-shaded color. For each stripe, paint 2-3 coats of color. Allow your project to dry.
- 6. Gently remove each Art Tape strip from the plate surface.
- 7. Use a script or liner brush to outline the daisy petals and daisy center using 1-2 coats of Tuxedo.
- 8. Use a Dotting Gyre to add Tuxedo dots to the daisy center.
- 9. Use the Dotting Gyre to add Cotton Tail dots to the daisy petals.



- 10. Use the Dotting Gyre to add smaller, Cotton Tail dots to the daisy center.
- 11. In scattered areas on the color bursts, use the Dotting Gyre to apply Dandelion (not mixed with Cotton Tail) dots.
- 12. Use a small round brush to add Cotton Tail petals around each Dandelion dot to create mini daisies across your project.
- **13.** Let your project dry completely. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
