INSTRUCTIONS

1. Dust off the planter with a dry hydra art sponge.
2. Add a strip of 1/8 inch art tape down the center of the front fender of the moped (Under the headlight to the top of the front tire).
3. Use the tape to create 4 stripe sections on the side of the planter. Tip: Make sure all of the tape is securely stuck down with no bubbles or wrinkles.
4. Paint 2-3 coats of Seabreeze on the outside of the planter using a fan brush, avoiding the taped sections on the side. Be sure to paint over the tape on the front fender. Tip: use the square shader brush to get in hard to paint areas behind the handlebars.
5. Paint 2-3 coats of Bluebeard inside of the planter using a fan brush.
6. Paint the 4 stripe sections with 2-3 coats of Basketball, Tiger Tail, Bluebeard, and Toad-Ily Green using the square shader brush.
7. Paint 2 coats of Butter Me Up inside the headlight using the script and detail liner brushes.
8. While the glaze is still damp, carefully peel up all the tape on the stripes and the front fender. This should reveal crisp white stripes. (Tip: If any glaze seeped under the tape, let the glaze completely dry and use sandpaper to remove those spots).
9. Using a variety of brushes, paint the tires and handlebars with 2 coats of Tuxedo. Leave the "walls" of the tires white for a vintage look.
10. Outline the headlight and add cross hatching over the light with Tuxedo using a detail liner brush.
11. Add Tuxedo detail lines to the side steps of the moped.
12. Mix a dot of Seabreeze with a dot of Tuxedo to create a gray color. Use this color to paint in the rims.
13. Use the gray mixture to add cross hatching details to the handlebars.
14. When the Seabreeze is completely dry on the opposite side of the stripes, use a pencil to lightly sketch "Just Roll With It" on the side in your desired font.
15. Use Bluebeard, Basketball, and Toad-Ily Green to paint 2 coats over the lettering using either the detail liner brush or script liner brush.
16. Use the assorted colors to add simple flower, leaf, and dash embellishments around the lettering as desired.
17. Touch up any areas on the rim or around the tires with Seabreeze as needed.
18. Clear glaze and fire to Cone 06. Enjoy!
