



## MATERIALS

- 3237** Lighted Bailee The Whale
- 9599** Hydra Art Sponge
- RB110** 10/0 Detail Liner
- CB604** #4 Soft Fan

## GLAZES

- EL103** Sea Spray
- EL124** Stormy Blue
- EL101** Oyster Shell
- PC601** Clear Cascade
- PC602** White Cascade



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the bisque with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Antique your project: use a soft fan brush to paint the ribbed belly of the whale with 1 coat of Stormy Blue. Dampen a Hydra Art Sponge, then use the damp sponge to wipe away the excess glaze whilst leaving the color in the ribbed crevices.
3. Use a soft fan brush to paint 2 coats of Oyster Shell over the ribbed belly and on the bottom of each flipper.
4. Paint 2-3 coats of Sea Spray on the whale's back and the top of each flipper.
5. While the glaze is still wet, add brushstrokes of Stormy Blue on the whale's back and lightly brush and blend them in with the Sea Spray.
6. Paint 1 thin layer of Clear Cascade over the entire whale's back.
7. Dab some White Cascade down the center of the whale's back.
8. Use a detail liner brush and 1 coat of Stormy Blue to fill in the eyes and mouth crease.
9. No need to clear glaze! Fire to cone 06 and enjoy!
