

OCEAN GLOW WHALE LANTERN



MATERIALS

3237 Lighted Bailee The Whale

9599 Hydra Art Sponge

RB110 10/0 Detail Liner

CB604 #4 Soft Fan

GLAZES

EL103 Sea Spray

EL124 Stormy Blue

EL101 Oyster Shell

PC601 Clear Cascade

PC602 White Cascade

INSTRUCTIONS



- 2. Antique your project: use a soft fan brush to paint the ribbed belly of the whale with 1 coat of Stormy Blue. Dampen a Hydra Art Sponge, then use the damp sponge to wipe away the excess glaze whilst leaving the color in the ribbed crevices.
- **3.** Use a soft fan brush to paint 2 coats of Oyster Shell over the ribbed belly and on the bottom of each flipper.
- **4.** Paint 2-3 coats of Sea Spray on the whale's back and the top of each flipper.
- **5.** While the glaze is still wet, add brushstrokes of Stormy Blue on the whale's back and lightly brush and blend them in with the Sea Spray.
- **6.** Paint 1 thin layer of Clear Cascade over the entire whale's back.
- **7.** Dab some White Cascade down the center of the whale's back.
- **8.** Use a detail liner brush and 1 coat of Stormy Blue to fill in the eyes and mouth crease.
- **9.** No need to clear glaze! Fire to cone 06 and enjoy!
