INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the tray with a clean Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Position the tray so that the egg slots are upside down (fat end on top, skinny end on bottom).
3. Use a pencil to lightly sketch strawberry shapes inside each egg slot. Leave some room at the top for leaves.
4. Sketch small leaves on top of each strawberry as desired.
5. Pour a quarter-sized amount of Hot Tamale, Ruby Slippers, and Candy Apple Red on the palette.
6. Use a #6 Round Brush and paint splotches of all 3 colors inside the strawberry outlines, layering the colors as you do so. You will want to coat each strawberry with at least 2 coats of color.
7. Using the #2 Round Brush and Detail Liner brush, paint 1-2 coats of Green Thumb inside the strawberry leaves.
8. Use the Detail Liner brush to add Army Surplus outlines and details on the leaves.
9. Time to plan your strawberry assortment! Use a pencil to lightly label what kind of strawberry you want to create for each slot (ex. Chocolate, Plain, Drizzled, Vanilla). Yum!
10. On the chocolate strawberries, paint 2-3 coats of Brown Cow on the bottom half of each strawberry.
11. On the Vanilla strawberries, paint 2-3 coats of Vanilla Dip on each bottom half.
12. Using a Detail Liner brush, paint tiny Tuxedo dots and dashes on the red areas of each strawberry to create the look of seeds.
13. Fill one detail writer bottle with a small amount of Java Bean. Fill another detail writer bottle with Vanilla Dip. Use each color to add drizzle over some of the strawberries. Feel free to leave some strawberries plain!
14. Use the Vanilla Dip writer bottle to add a small detail stroke on each chocolate dipped strawberry. This will give the strawberry a nice gleam!
15. Using the Detail Liner, add dots and dabs of Crackerjack Brown over the Vanilla-dipped strawberries. Think cake crumbs and ground nuts, mmm!
16. Using the Detail Liner, add organic outlines around the strawberries, leaves, and dipped parts using Tuxedo.

Optional: Dip a toothbrush into Tuxedo. Hold the toothbrush near your piece, then use your finger to flick the bristles towards the tray. This will create a fun splatter look on your piece!

17. Once dry, clear glaze and fire to Cone 06. Enjoy!
