

FUNGI FRUITFLY TRAP

MATERIALS

3248 Fungi Fruitfly Trap

9599 Hydra Art Sponge

Assorted Brushes

GLAZES

SC011 Blue Yonder

SC086 Old Lace

SC031 The Blues

SC088 Tu Tu Tango

SC045 My Blue Heaven

SC095 Pinkie Swear

SC053 Purple Haze



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the piece with a dry Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Paint the top half of the mushroom cap with 2-3 coats of Blue Yonder.
3. Paint the bottom half of the mushroom cap with 2-3 coats of The Blues, blending the two different shades as you apply coats.
4. Paint the edge of the mushroom cap with 2-3 coats of Purple Haze.
5. Dampen a brush, then use the damp brush to blend the colors where they meet on the mushroom cap. This will create a beautiful ombre color effect!
6. On the textured gills beneath the mushroom cap, paint the top half (closest to the outer edge) with 2-3 coats of Pinkie Swear.
7. Paint the bottom half of the textured gills with 2-3 coats of Tu Tu Tango.
8. Use the damp brush to blend the colors where they meet on the gills.
9. Use a detail liner brush to accent the textured gill lines with Purple Haze.
10. On the base of the fruit fly trap, apply triangular splashes of Tu Tu Tango near the rim, creating a scalloped effect.
11. Paint the remaining area of the base with Old Lace.
12. Use the damp brush to blend the colors where they meet on the base.
13. Use a detail liner brush to accent each engraved line on the base with Blue Yonder.
14. Add My Blue Heaven polka dots, in various sizes, to the top of the mushroom cap.
15. Prior to firing, if needed, use a mascara brush tool or pipe cleaner to unclog any holes with excess glaze.
16. Clear glaze and fire to cone 06. Enjoy!
